Important Information

- WEBSITE:** The official tournament website is www.sacramentoasa.org; then click on the National Championship link.
- FORMAT:** Pool Play then Double Elimination
- UNIFORMS:** All players must compete in accordance with Rule 3, Section 6, of the 2012 ASA Official Rules of Softball.
- LINE-UP FORMS:** Tournament officials will provide line-up forms for each team.
- GAME TIMES:** Please follow the times listed on the official tournament bracket. Game time is forfeit time. Teams should be prepared to start a game immediately after the proceeding game is completed.
- INFIELD PRACTICE:** No field practice will be permitted. Warm-up is allowed in designated areas only. Teams may warm-up in the outfield grass beyond the temporary fencing if time permits. We will make fields available for practices and or friendlies. Teams wishing to schedule a practice time may contact Cassi Rogers at crogers@sacramentoasa.org.
- DUGOUTS:** Players, Coaches, and a bat person are the only individuals allowed in the dugout. Home team and visiting team will be determined by a coin toss when line-ups are turned in to the home plate umpire. Bottom of the bracket occupies the third base dugout unless team has back-to-back games.
- GIFT EXCHANGE:** As is customary at National Tournaments, each team will participate in a gift exchange. You will exchange gifts immediately following your first pool play game. For gift exchange ideas, please visit our website.
- PLAYING RULES:** All playing rules and regulations for the tournament will be in accordance with the 2012 ASA Official Rules of Softball.
- CONDUCT:** Managers and coaches are asked to have complete control of the players and parents on their team both on and off the field. Any report of damages by hotel management will be dealt with by the tournament committee.

- PLAYER PASSES:** Player passes will be distributed to rostered players and three coaches per team.
- ADMISSION:** Tournament Passes Adult \$40.00
Tournament Passes Child \$20.00 (6-17 years of age)
Tournament Passes Senior \$20.00 (Over 65)
Daily Passes Adult \$10.00
Daily Passes Child \$5.00 (6-17 years of age)
Daily Passes Senior \$5.00 (Over 65)
Children 5 and Under FREE
- PLAYER CHECK IN:** Player Check-In will be from 2:30pm - 5:30pm. Please bring your entire team at one time to make the process run as smoothly as possible. Individual players who are coming late may check in at any time prior to participating in a game.
- SOUVENIRS:** Souvenirs will be available throughout the weekend at Maidu Park & other locations as needed.
- PARKING:** There is no charge for parking and adequate parking is available at all fields. For overnight parking, please request a list of RV Parks.
- INCLEMENT WEATHER:** In the event of inclement weather, the game must be resumed at the exact point where it was suspended. It is the manager's responsibility to report to the fields for rain out information. If severe weather should occur and teams have to depart the field we have a HOT LINE (916) 622-9060 which is updated and will let you know play status and when to report back to the fields or you may visit our website at www.sacramentoasa.org.

| Varying price ranges with many selected amenities that teams enjoy such as laundry facilities, breakfast options, and willingness to work with youth groups. | No laundry facilities, no food options, unsure of the quality, unwillingness to work with youth groups. May be in unusual or undesirable locations. |
| Nearby shopping, restaurants and other youth related attractions. | May be inconvenient to attractions that we know our youth groups enjoy |
| Adds to your Tournament Experience as you are in the middle of the action including opening ceremonies, other games and closing ceremonies. | Far from the action causing the players and families to be separate from the tournament activities. |
| Selected hotels and properties make it possible for GSSA to bring events to the local community. | Have no connection with softball or the local community that brings events to the Region. |
| Prices are reasonable. | You may pay less, but you get far less. |

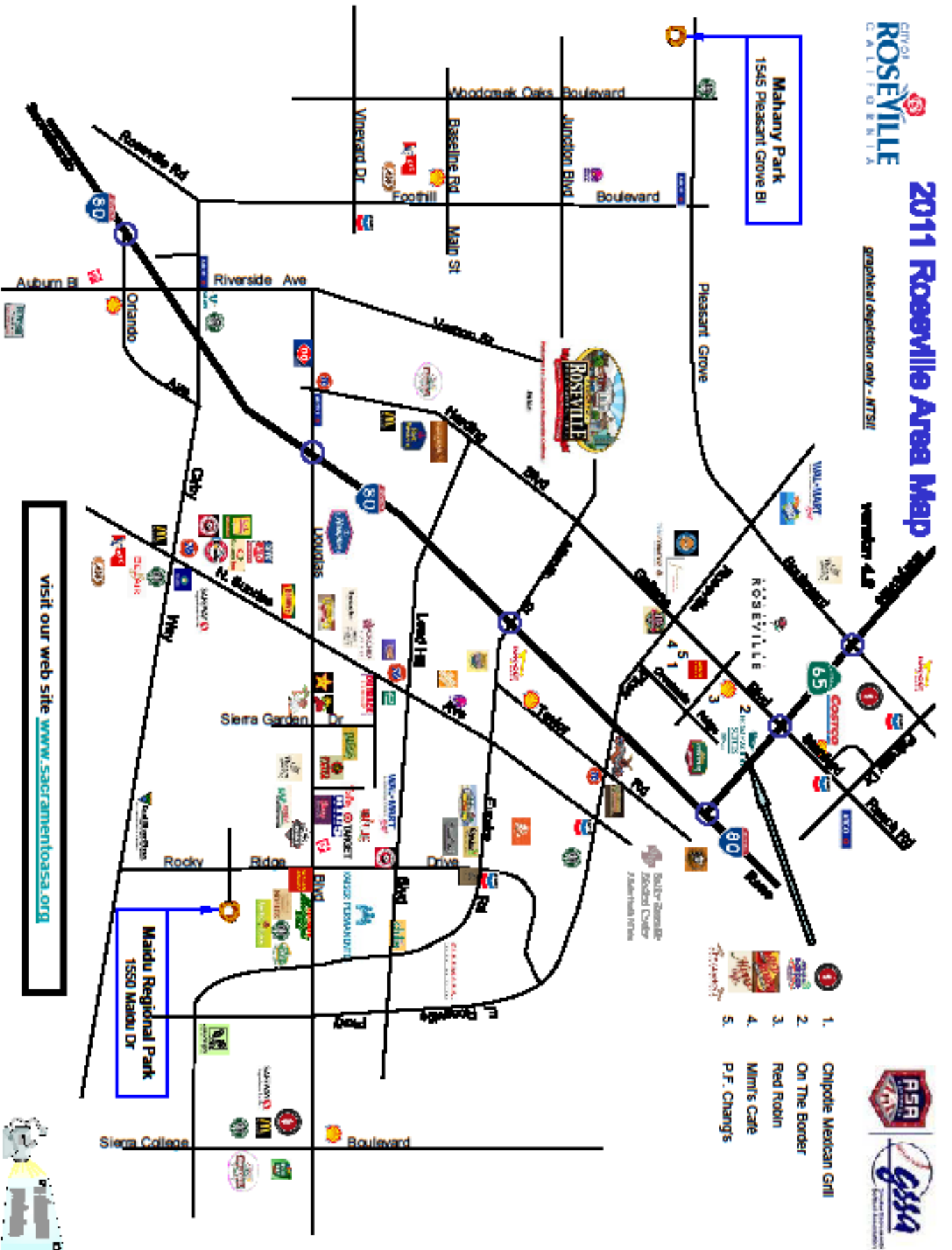
