COMPETITION RULES

- All participants must provide a copy of a valid birth certificate or baptismal record at all levels of competition.
- Each youngster may participate in only one local competition. Competing in more than one local will result in disqualification of that individual.
- No metal spikes are allowed during any portion of the competition.
- In the event of a tie for the All-Around Champion, the youngster winning more individual events (Pitching, Hitting or Running), among those involved with the tie, will be named the All-Around Champion. If a tie still exists, the youngster with the higher Hitting score among those involved with the tie, will be named the All-Around Champion. If a tie still exists, the Running scores of those involved with the tie will be used to determine the All-Around Champion. There is no tiebreaker in the individual skill events.
- In the event of threatening weather conditions, cancellations and rescheduling will be determined by the hosting organization at the competition site.
- Major League Baseball®, LEJ Sports Group and state coordinators and organizers of the PITCH, HIT & RUN™ competition reserve the right to make rulings and recommendations regarding the competition events determined to be in the best interest of the program. All rulings and recommendations are final.

OVERVIEW

New to Aquafina® Major League Baseball® PITCH, HIT & Run™ is the launch of a pilot program – A Girls Softball Division! In conjunction with American Softball Association (ASA), PITCH, HIT & Run™ has implemented the Girls Softball Division in 10 markets across the country.

The Girls Softball Division of PITCH, HIT & Run™ is intended to provide girls with the opportunity to participate in an exciting softball skills competition, while showcasing their pitching, hitting and running abilities. Testing the three most fundamental skills of softball – pitching/throwing, hitting and running, each event is scored individually and converted to a total point score through use of conversion tables to determine the All-Around Champion.



PITCH: Participant is tested throwing six (6) strikes to a designated “Strike Zone” target. Both underhand pitching and overhand throwing are permitted. Distance is 35 feet.

HIT: Youngster receives three (3) attempts to hit a ball off a stationary tee for distance and accuracy.



RUN: Participant is timed in a sprint from second base, touching third then home. Total running distance is 120 total feet.

LEVELS OF COMPETITION/ HOW TO ADVANCE

In the Girls Softball Division of PITCH, HIT & Run™ there are three (3) levels of competition – Local, Super Regional and National Finals. The first level is of local scope and will be hosted by an ASA Softball League. Everyone **MUST** participate in a local competition in order to advance to Super Regional Competition. The 1st Place All-Around, Pitching, Hitting and Running Champions in each age group advance to the Super Regional Competition.

At the Super Regional Competition, all scores are reset to zero and all participants compete in all of the skills to determine the Champions. The 1st Place All-Around Champions in each age group from the Super Regional Competition then becomes eligible to advance to the National Finals.

After the Super Regional Competitions are complete, the 1st Place All-Around Champions in each age group are ranked nationally by total score. The Champions’ scores from all 10 markets are compared and the top three (3) scorers in each age group nationwide advance to the National Finals in St. Louis, MO at the 2009 MLB® All-Star Game®.
