



GIRLS FAST PITCH LEAGUE

Rules & Guidelines

1. LEAGUE REGISTRATION POLICY & PROCEDURES

- A) Full league fees are due at the time of registration.
- B) League will be limited to 8 teams per age group.
- C) When league is full, teams will be placed on a waiting list.

2. REFUND POLICY

- A) A team withdrawing prior to 14 days before the start of the league will be given a full refund minus a \$50 administrative fee.
- B) A team withdrawing 1-13 days before the start of the league will be given a full refund minus a \$100 administrative fee.
- C) A team withdrawing after the start of the league will not be given a refund.
- D) No refunds will be given for no-shows.

3. MAKE UP GAMES

- A) Make up games will be rescheduled at the end of the season before playoffs. Make up games may be scheduled on different nights, times and or locations due to scheduling conflicts.
- B) Games will be subject to make up for rain outs, black outs, protests or other reasons under the discretion of the league director. GSSA reserves the right to not reschedule games or refund money.

4. FORFEITS

- A) A team will be assessed a \$20 forfeit fee for the first forfeit. If a 2nd forfeit occurs, the team will be assessed a \$40 fee and subject to suspension from further play. On the 3rd forfeit, the team will be suspended from the league.
- B) Should a team call 24 hours prior to the start of the game, the forfeit fee will be waived.
- C) Two forfeits in a season and the team will not be eligible for playoffs.
- D) Forfeits will count as 1.5 losses in the standings.

5. GAME TIME

- A) Game time is forfeit time. There is no grace period.
- B) Game time is no new inning after an hour and fifteen minutes. At one hour and twenty five minutes, time will drop dead.
- C) If time drops dead, score will revert back to last completed inning.

6. PLAYOFFS

- A) A team forfeiting twice in the course of a season is not eligible for play offs.
- B) The top 4 teams based on standings will compete in playoffs.
- C) Players must check in for play offs with photo ID.
- D) The championship game will be played with no time limit to seven innings.
- E) In the championship game, the top seed will be the home team.
- F) The top four teams will be decided in the following order:
 - 1. Overall Record
 - 2. Head to Head
 - 3. Least Runs Allowed
 - 4. Most Runs Scored

7. ELIGIBILITY & ROSTER REQUIREMENTS

- A) Each roster must consist of 10-20 players. All players who participate, must be listed on roster. They must be registered players in the ASA system.
- B) Any adult who participates on the field or in the dugout must be registered in the ASA system and wear their ID card at all times.
- C) Players may be added up until the 4th game of the season. After the 4th game, the roster will be frozen until the completion of playoffs.
- D) Teams are subject to eligibility requirements as set out in the ASA code and Sacramento rules.

8. PLAYING RULES

- A) Playing rules will be according to the ASA Official Rules of Softball.
- B) Coaches have the option to bat any amount of players
- C) Free substitutions.

9. AWARDS

- A) Awards will be given to listed participants on the team roster.
