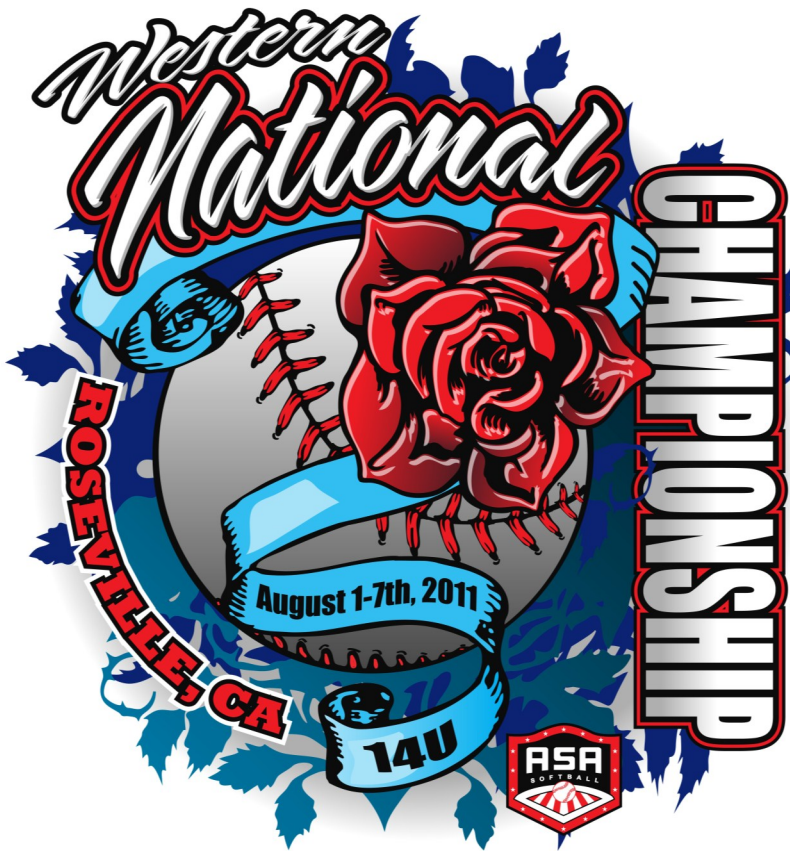


Opening Day

Manager Check-In

Time: 10:45am - 11:45am

Manager Check-In is when you officially check your team into the tournament. Please make sure to get there early as check-in will CLOSE at 11:45am. When you check-in the Tournament Director will verify that you have turned in all necessary paperwork including:

Hotel Report

Once all paperwork is turned in, you will receive a welcome bag for your team with menus of local restaurants, coupons, batting cage tokens and other goodies.

You will also receive your pre-order gate passes at this time.



Manager Luncheon

Location: Maidu Community Center, 1550 Maidu Drive, Roseville CA 95661
Time: 12:00pm - 1:30pm

Each team is allowed to send 2 team representatives to the Manager Luncheon. **No additional tickets will be available to this luncheon** as we are limited in the capacity that the room holds. Please do not bring additional coaches as they will be turned away at the door.

After lunch is served, the managers will be addressed by the ASA Commissioner, the Tournament Director, the ASA Representative and the Umpire-In-Chief about the tournament and the expectations for a National Championship.



Parking Options

Parking Options

1. Woodcreek High School

Woodcreek High School is the location of opening ceremonies and will have the entire school parking lot available to us.

2. Roseville Aquatic Center

The Aquatic Center is right next door to the High School and has parking in front and in back.

3. Across from Aquatic Center

There is a dirt lot across the street from the Aquatic Center that will be available for the Opening Ceremonies.

4. Mahany Sports Complex

There is a walking path between Mahany and Woodcreek High School.

5. Raley's Shopping Center

The shopping center should be used for overflow parking only.

Drop-Off Locations

1. Woodcreek High School

A drop off location will be available at the High School if people wish to drop off players or spectators.



Player Check-In

Location: Mahany Sports Center, 1545 Pleasant Grove Blvd, Roseville
Time: 2:30pm - 6:30pm

Every individual must individually check-in for this tournament with photo ID and proof of age. Player check-in will be done at Mahany Sports Center.

To make the check-in process smooth, your team will be asked to line outside in the order as they appear on your Championship Roster. Once they are in the correct order, you will be brought inside to one of the check-in stations.

Each player must show their Register ASA Photo ID card or other acceptable photo and proof of age. (See below). Once the player shows their ID, they will be asked to sign in on the official sign-in sheet. Every player who signs in will receive a gate pass for the week.

LATE CHECK-IN:

Have a player coming later in the week? That's ok. They will need to check-in with the tournament director PRIOR to participating in any way with the team. The only place for late check-in will be the main softball complex which is Maidu Park. That means if your team is playing at a different park, the player will need to first come to Maidu, check-in with ID and then go to your field.

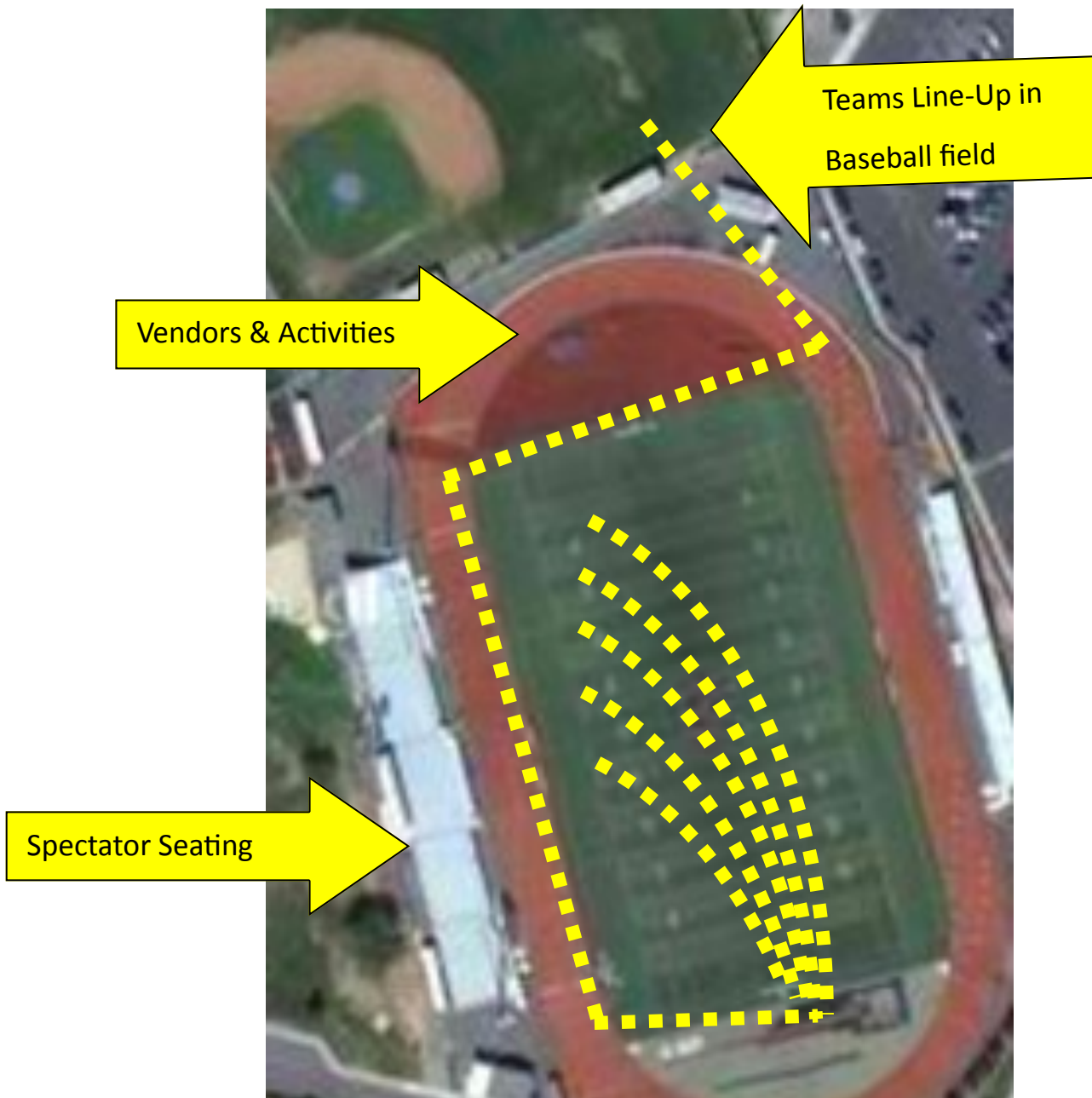


Team Line-Up

Location: Woodcreek High School, 2551 Woodcreek Oaks Blvd, Roseville
Time: 6:30pm - 7:00pm

In order to get through 100+ teams in a timely manner, it is important to keep your team organized. Teams will be instructed to line up in the grassy field BEHIND the Football Stadium. Please find your team sign and have your players/coaches line-up behind the sign in single-file.

ONLY players and coaches should be in this area. No parents.





Opening Ceremonies

Location: Woodcreek High School, 2551 Woodcreek Oaks Blvd, Roseville

At opening ceremonies there will be a lot going on. Use this page as a guide so you will know everything that is being offered.

Gate Passes: Attending opening ceremonies is free of charge. However, it is a great time to purchase a weekly gate pass that will take care of admission for the entire week. For every gate pass that is purchased, you will also receive a ball for “Chuck-A-Ball” game played at Opening Ceremonies.

Adult Weekly Pass - \$40

Adult Daily Pass - \$10

Child or Senior Weekly Pass - \$20

Child or Senior Daily Pass - \$5

Chuck-A-Ball: Inspired by a contest conducted at a hockey game, Chuck-A-Ball was created by Sacramento ASA Commissioner, Jeff Dubchansky. Each person who purchases a week long pass to the tournament prior to opening ceremonies will receive a foam ball. Balls can also be purchased in packs of six for \$5.00 or individually for \$1.00. Each ball will have a number written with a corresponding ticket which you will keep. When directed, everyone with a ball will “chuck” their balls on to the field and try to get their ball to land in a bucket. Balls in buckets will get prizes.

Inflatables: Inflatable activities will be available for all ages before the Opening Ceremonies begin. There will be an obstacle course, interactive game and a jump house.

Photo Booths: There will be 3 photo booths available before opening ceremonies. Take a couple of friends or your whole team and take some photos. Free prints all night.

Vendors: Many vendors will be set-up during Opening Ceremonies and through out the week. There will be equipment vendors, food vendors, balance necklaces, hair ribbons, sunglasses, etc.
